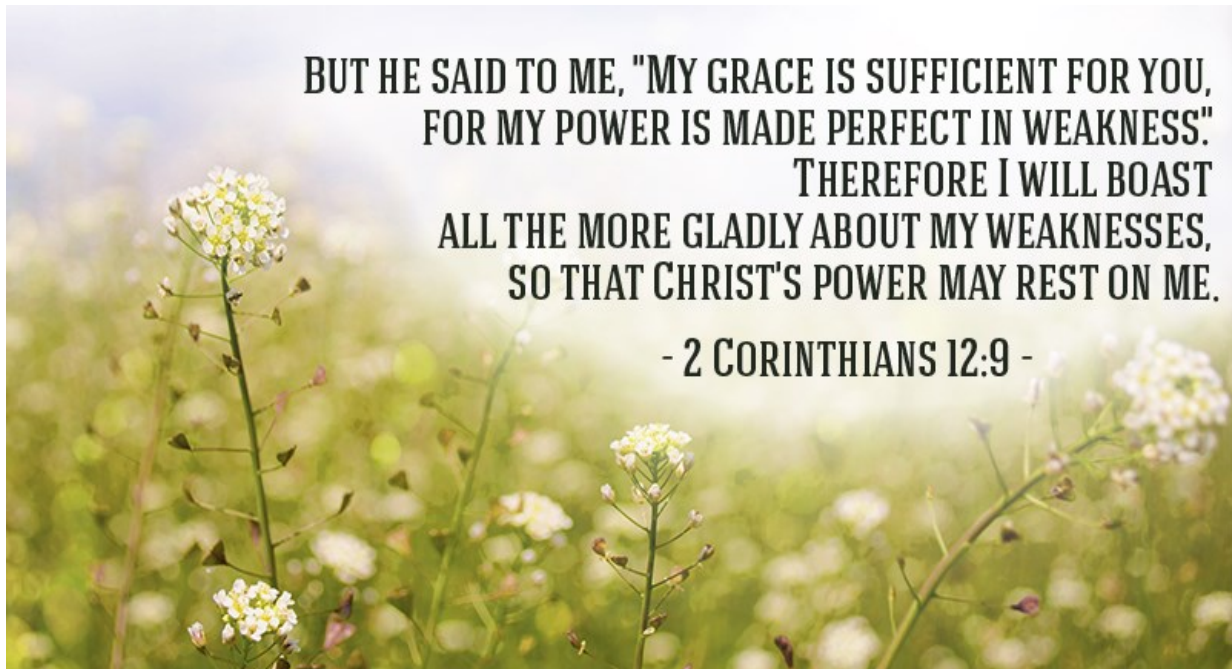

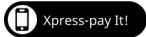

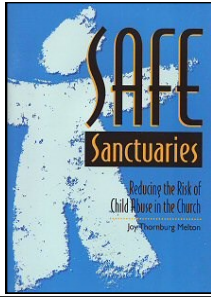

** The text of our anthem today is set to a melody written by the English composer Gustav Holst. The tune is named THAXTED and is based on a theme from the "Jupiter" movement of his orchestral suite "The Planets." Thaxted is the name of an English village where Holst lived for many years

The tune name for each hymn in our hymnal is found at the bottom right of each page, always in all capital letters

The hymn tune for our opening hymn today is AZMON. It was written by Carl Glaser and arranged by Lowell Mason in 1839. Mason is widely considered to be the "father of public school music education in American." AZMON is the name of a city south of Canaan which appears in Numbers 34:4
