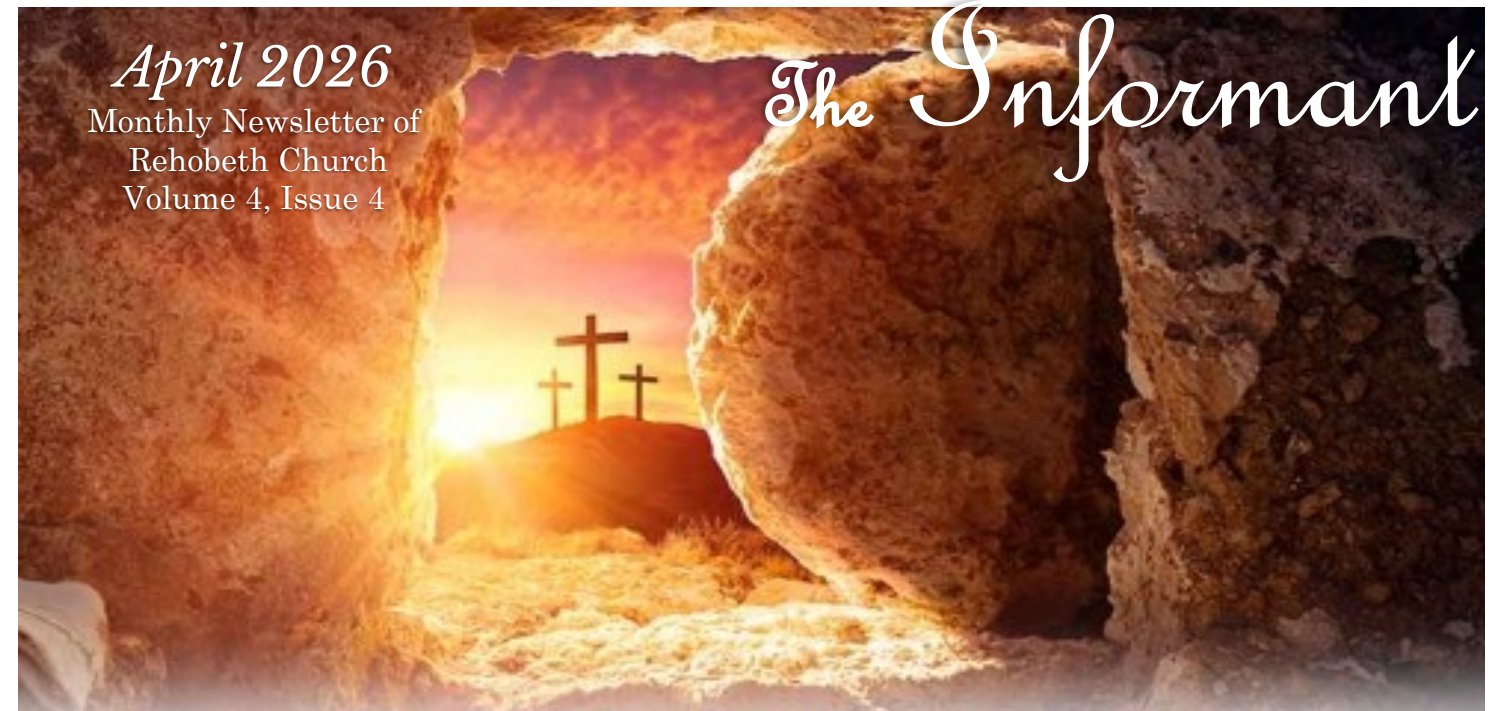

Mauddy Thursday (April 2) - Read **John 13:1-17, 31-35** Consider what you are doing to live out Jesus' command to love one another.

Good Friday (April 3) - Read **John 18:1-19, 42** and spend a few moments in silence.

Holy Saturday (April 4) Read **Matthew 25:57-66** Christ's body lays in the tomb, imagine how the disciples felt.

Easter Sunday (April 5) Celebrate the Good News of Jesus' resurrection and victory over death and darkness.

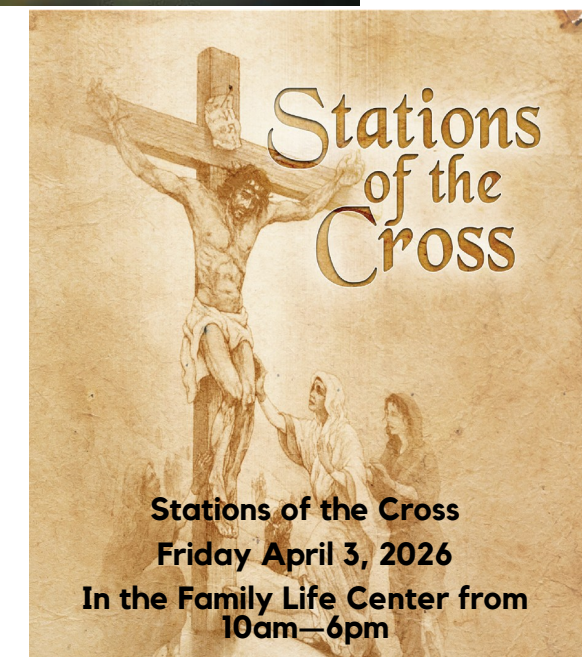
