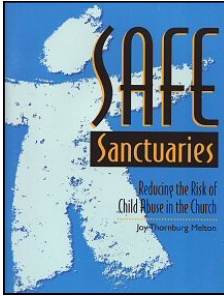

**Precious Lord, Take My Hand**

**History of the Hymn**

Our opening hymn for today was written by Thomas A Dorsey (1899-1993). Dorsey was an African American songwriter, singer, and pianist whose "blues" arrangements of gospel hymns earned him the title "Father of Gospel Music." *Precious Lord, Take My Hand*, the most celebrated of Dorsey's songs was composed in 1932. He had just experienced the tragedy of losing his wife Nettie in childbirth and shortly thereafter the death of the child. This song of faith came to Dorsey as he quietly fingered at the piano the old Sunday school tune MAITLAN,D, #424 in the hymnal. He sang it for the gospel singer and his friend, Theodore Frye, who the following Sunday introduced it with his choir at Ebenezer Baptist Church. On April 9, 1968 at an open-air service at Morehouse College following the funeral of Martin Luther King, Jr., Mahalia Jackson's memorable and compelling rendition introduced this gospel song and the performance practice of African American gospel music to millions worldwide via television and radio.
