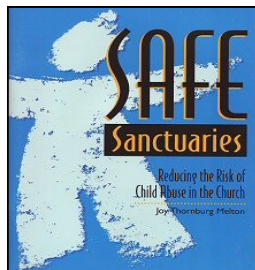


**TO OUR VISITORS:**

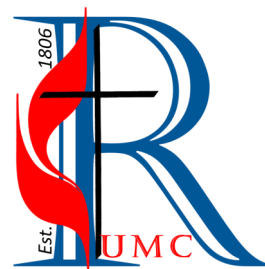

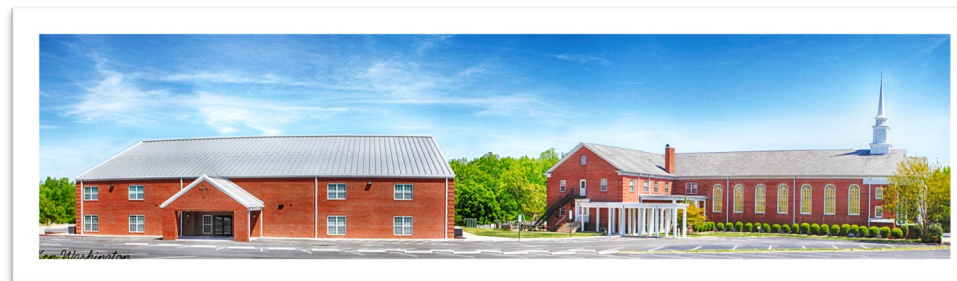
